• N.Y. City – the largest city in the U.S.A.








### Niagara Falls

- **Texas** is the second most populous (after California) and the second largest of the 50 states (after Alaska).
- **Houston** is the largest city in Texas and the fourth-largest city in the U.S.A.
- Due to its long history as a center of the cattle industry, Texas is associated with the image of the cowboy. The state's economic fortunes changed in the early 20th century, when oil discoveries initiated an economic boom in the state.
- Texas emits the most greenhousegases in the U.S.
- J.F. Kennedy (the 35th president) was assassinated in Dallas, Texas on November 22, 1963.

• The John F. Kennedy Space Center (KSC) is the United States launch site that has been used for every NASA human space flight since December 1968.












### <u>The Northwest Region</u> – consists of 9 states




