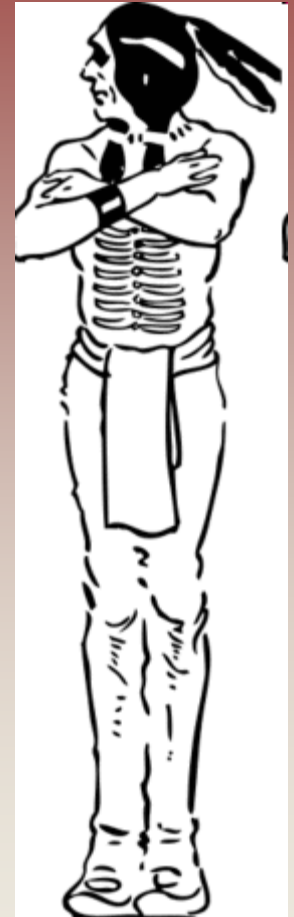

New York – the inner city

- **It lies in the state of New York**
- **The central part of the city has as many inhabitants as the whole Czech Republic**
- **It is usually called “Big Apple” or “Melting Pot”**

Short history

- **New York was originally inhabited by Native Americans (Indigenous people)**
- **It was bought from the Native Americans by Dutch people for \$25**
- **Then, they named it New Amsterdam, later it was re-named New York**



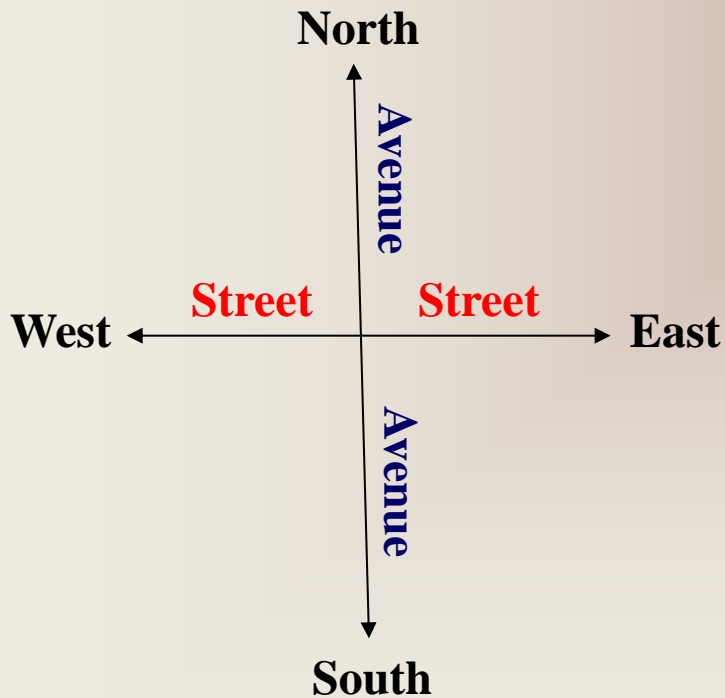
Major parts

 5. Staten Island



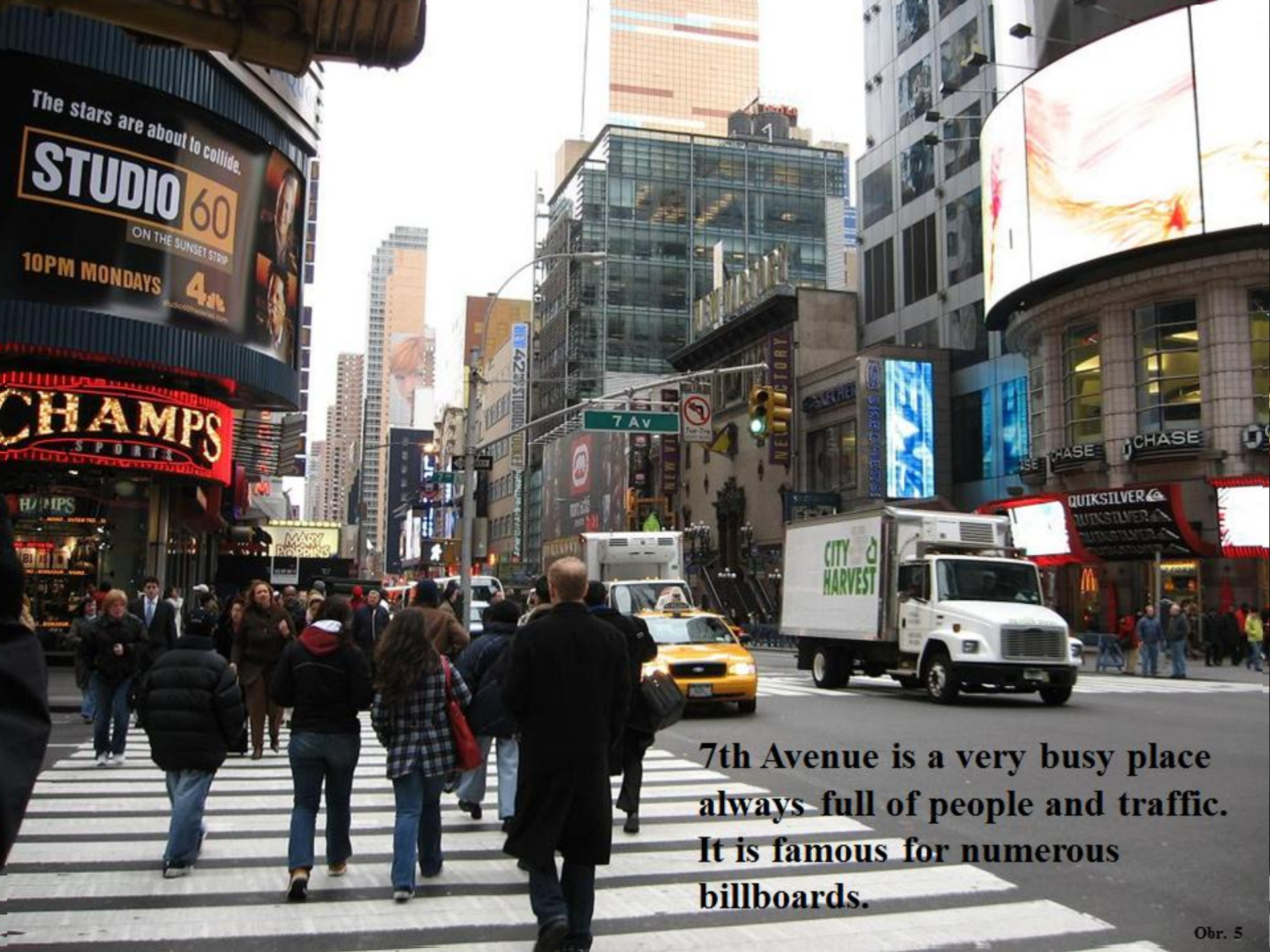

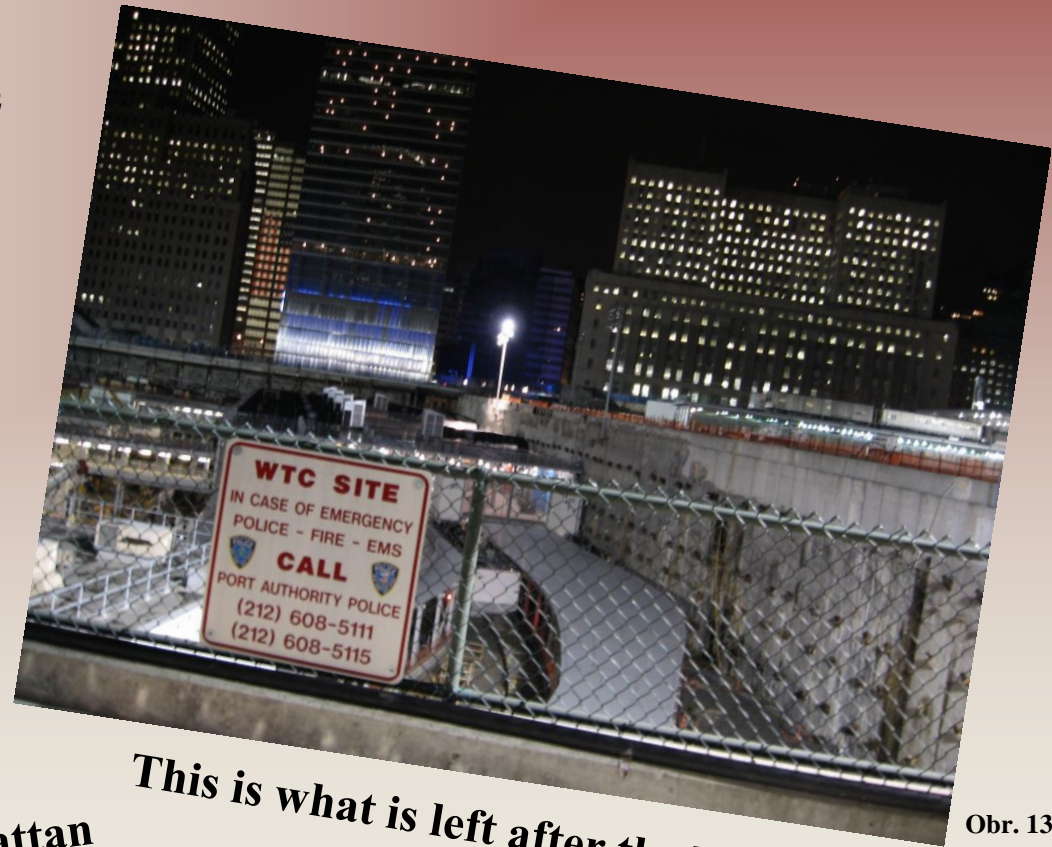
You cannot see there the Twins (World Trade Center) anymore because it was completely destroyed in the terrorist attack (September 11, 2001)

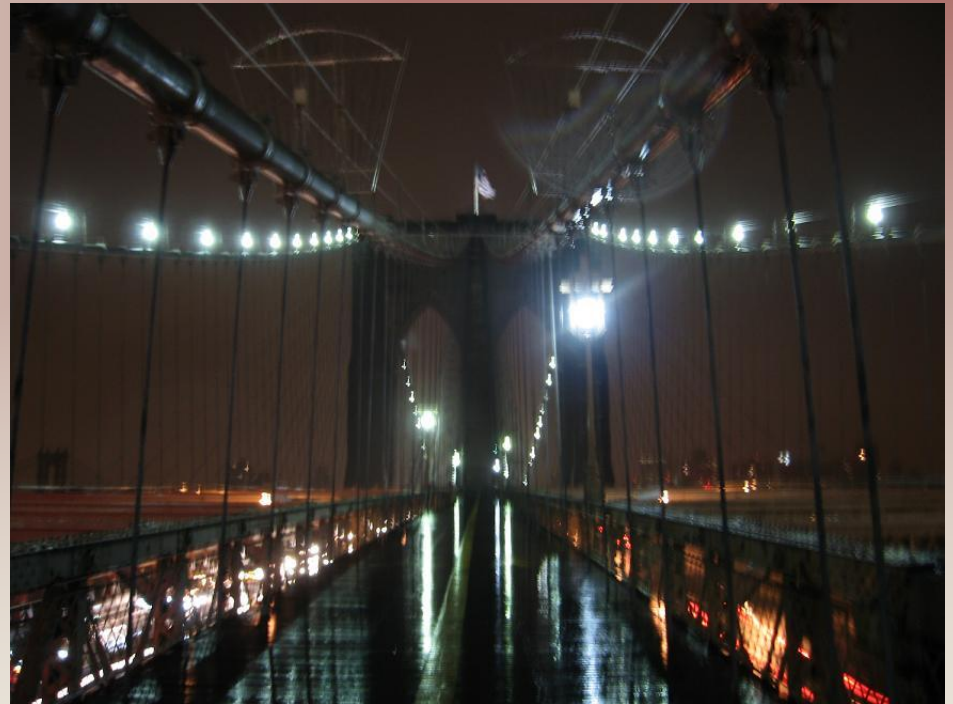
Freedom Tower

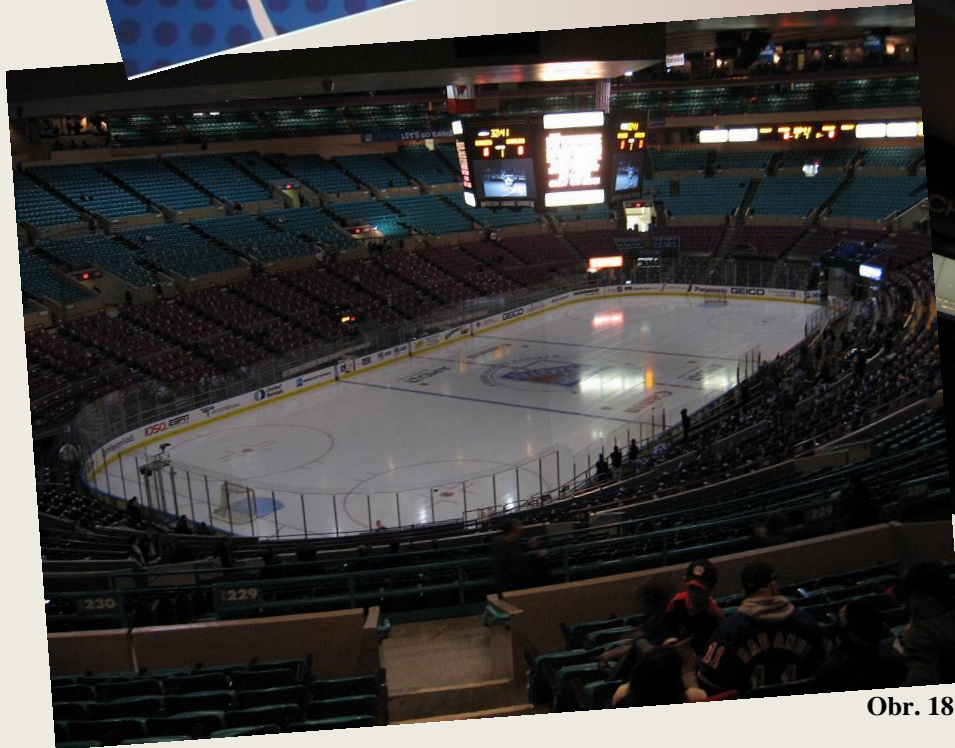

Night life in NY City

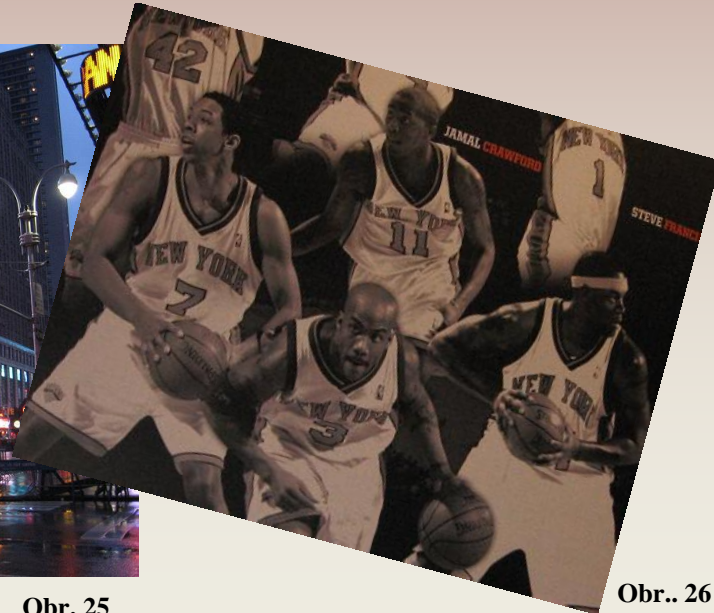
